# GRAND SLAM GIVEAWAY:

## City offers residents FREE tickets to world-class tennis tournament

From March 11th through the 18th, Sunrise will host the BMW Tennis Championship - a prestigious tournament featuring the top names in men's professional tennis. As a special benefit, the City is offering FREE general admission tickets through its Grand Slam Giveaway, so residents can enjoy the excitement first hand.

Don't miss out on an opportunity to attend this action-packed event FREE of charge. Each household is eligible for two general admission tickets to one session of the tournament. Please see the session schedule (lower right) for dates and times. FREE tickets are available per session, and proof of Sunrise residency\* is required. Each weekday general admission ticket has a retail value of \$10.00, and general admission tickets for weekend sessions are valued at \$15.00.

FREE tickets must be picked up in person at the Box Office of the Sunrise Civic Center, located at 10610 West Oakland Park Boulevard. For residents' convenience, the Box Office will have extended operating hours - Tuesdays through Fridays from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., and Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. - from Tuesday, February 13th until Tuesday, March 13th.

FREE tickets will be distributed only during that time frame, and only while supplies last.

"The BMW Tennis Championship is a world-class event," said **Mayor Steven Feren**. "We're pleased to offer our residents an opportunity to see some of the top-ranked male players - right here at our own facility."

In 2007, the tournament will mark its third year in Sunrise, after a move from Boca Raton. The event's current home - Sunrise Tennis Club, located at 9605 West Oakland Park Boulevard - is recognized as the premier public tennis facility in South Florida. The Club features 10 state-of-the-art Hydrocourt clay courts, one tournament court, four asphalt-based cushioned courts, and a clubhouse with a pro shop, players' lounge and locker rooms.

Plans for a \$3.5 million expansion, currently in the design phase, include a new tournament court in a park-like setting, complete with an exercise trail, shade pavilions and a tot lot.

The BMW Tennis Championship is the only Association of Tennis Professionals (ATP) event held in Broward County, and one of only three major tournaments in the state of Florida. The ATP is the organizer of the principal worldwide men's tennis tour. Under the terms of the agree-

ment between the City and event organizers, the tournament will be held in Sunrise through 2008, with an option to renew through 2013.

Last year's tournament attracted a variety of dynamic, talented players, including singles winner Dmitry Tursunov of Russia, currently ranked #22 in the world. In 2006,

Tursunov won three singles titles and reached the round of 16 at Wimbledon. He also helped propel Team Russia to Davis Cup victory, defeating the U.S.A.'s Andy Roddick 17-15 in the thrilling five-set semifinal deciding match.

Additional general admission tickets may be purchased for all tournament sessions at a 10% discount by visiting the Sunrise Tennis Club weekdays between 8:00 a.m. and 9:30 p.m., and from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on weekends. Other non-general admission tickets are available at \$15 for weekday sessions, \$20 for the semifinals and \$25 for the finals. Box seat packages are available for \$800 and include four reserved seats for each of the eleven sessions.
