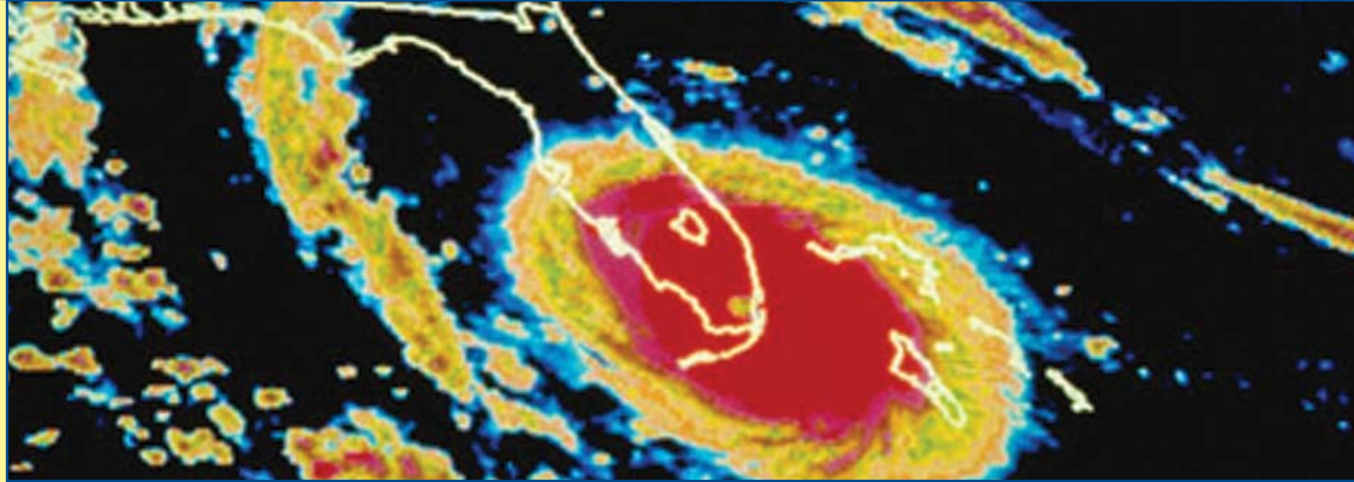

COUNTY LAUNCHES VULNERABLE POPULATION REGISTRY

Broward County has announced the launch of a **Vulnerable Population Registry**, created as a joint effort between County government, local municipalities and emergency responders county-wide. Residents are encouraged to register if they feel they may be vulnerable - due to a disability, frailty or health issue - in the aftermath of a hurricane or other emergency, when extended power outages or temporary loss of services can occur.

The Registry is designed to help government entities and emergency responders pinpoint the locations of those people most in need. However, participation in the program is not a guarantee that a resident will be provided services or be placed on a priority list. Those who enroll with the Registry are still encouraged to be prepared for hurricane season, collecting essential supplies of food, water and medication to sustain themselves for three to five days in the aftermath of a storm.
