

# City to "Free" Chlorinate Water System

*Residents may notice a difference in taste, odor and color.*

The City of Sunrise maintains the highest quality standards to provide clean, safe drinking water to our Utilities Department customers, which include the cities of Sunrise, Weston, Southwest Ranches and parts of Davie.

**February 1 to February 21**, the Utilities Department will be using "free" chlorine in its drinking water treatment system to provide additional protection against bacteria.

This temporary treatment of the water system is a common practice for water suppliers that use a chlorine (chloramine) water treatment method. This periodic program is mandated by the Broward County Health Department.

The procedure does not cause any adverse health effects. However, some individuals may notice a slight change in the taste, odor or color of the water during this time. For more information regarding the City of Sunrise's treatment system, please contact the Utilities Department at (954) 888-6000.

# Sunrise Summer Camp Registration Begins March 2

March marks the return of registration for Sunrise's popular and affordable Summer Camp program. The City's Leisure Services Department operates camp sites throughout Sunrise, offering participants the best in summer recreation - from sports and swimming to arts and crafts. In addition, each camp session features a weekly field trip.

Sunrise offers four specialty camps: A Theatre Camp for kids with a flair for drama, and two Sports Camps that focuses on developing athletic ability. There's also an Adventurous Beginners Camp designed for children who will be entering kindergarten this fall.

Full-day camp programs are conducted every week-day from Monday, June 15 through Friday, August 7 from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. All camps will be closed on July 3 in observance of Independence Day.

Each camper will receive an official summer camp t-shirt, which must be worn on field trips. Campers must bring their own lunch and snacks each day.

## REGISTRATION TIPS

- No online registrations will be accepted.
- Completed registration forms must be received by U.S. Mail in a regular envelope only.
- Registration forms must be post marked on or after Monday, March 2.
- Assignment lottery begins Monday, March 16 for Sunrise Summer Camps. Registrations received by March 16, will be randomly selected and assigned a camp location according to choices selected on the registration form.
- Forms received after March 16 will be processed in the order they are received, space permitting.
- Dates and locations are subject to change based upon School Board approval.
- Assignment lottery is open to Sunrise Residents and Non-Residents with children who attend a Broward County Public School located in Sunrise. Non-residents must include proof of attendance at that school verifying enrollment for the fall and/or most recent report card.
- Registration for Non-Residents (those without children attending Sunrise schools) begins Tuesday, May 5 in the Leisure Services office or through the mail in registration system, space permitting.
- Registration verification will not be available by phone until after Monday, March 30.
