BMW Tennis Championship: World-Class Tennis Returns to Sunrise

From March 14 to March 21, the City of Sunrise will host the prestigious **BMW Tennis Championship**. This exciting event provides South Floridians with a rare opportunity to see some of the top men's professional tennis players in action.

The BMW Tennis Championship consistently draws a competitive field, thanks to its prime scheduling between the BNP Paribas Open (formerly the Pacific Life Open) in Indian Wells, California, and the Sony Ericsson Open in Key Biscayne.

In 2009, the tournament attracted an amazing nine of the world's top 50 players - including singles winner **Robin Soderling** of Sweden. Soderling went on to have a stellar year: He reached the finals of the French Open

(losing to Roger Federer) and is currently ranked #8 in the world.

The BMW Tennis Championship is the only Association of Tennis Professionals (ATP) event held in Broward County, and one of only three major tournaments in the state of Florida.

The tournament's home, **Sunrise Tennis Club** (9605 West Oakland Park Boulevard), has earned numerous accolades, including the United States Tennis Association's "Outstanding Facility" award.

Don't miss your opportunity to attend this action-packed event **free of charge**. Each household is eligible for two general admission tickets to one session of the tournament. Please see the session schedule (at right) for dates and times. Free tickets are available per session, and proof of Sunrise residency* is required. Each weekday (Tuesday through Friday) general admission ticket has a retail value of \$15.00. General admission tickets for the Semifinals (Saturday) and Finals (Sunday) are valued at \$25.00 and \$30.00 respectively.

Free tickets must be picked up in person at the Box Office of the Sunrise Civic Center (10610 West Oakland Park Boulevard) between February 9 and March 12. The Box Office is open Tuesday, Friday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and Wednesday and Thursday from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Free tickets will be distributed only during that time frame, and only while supplies last.

**Acceptable proof of residency includes a photo I.D. (a driver's license or state-issued identification card) AND one of the following: a utility bill (City of Sunrise, FPL, phone or cable), credit card statement or lease showing a Sunrise address.*
